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PURPOSE

This communicates revisions to the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs' (ADP), Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) Program, Aid Codes Master Chart. The revised Aid Codes Master Chart can be accessed using the following link on ADP's website: http://www.adp.ca.gov/Library/index.shtml

The chart identifies the aid codes that are authorized for use in the DMC Program administered by ADP. Certified DMC programs can receive reimbursement for providing medically necessary substance abuse treatment services to a Medi-Cal eligible beneficiary whose aid codes are identified on ADP's Aid Codes Master Chart.

DISCUSSION

ADP has made the following revisions to the Aid Codes Master Chart:

• Added Aid Code E1-The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has advised that the purpose of this code is to bridge otherwise eligible children who are unable to verify citizenship/identify past the reasonable period to the Healthy Families Program. The Bridging program currently provides one month of full-scope zero share of cost coverage using aid code 7X, a code previously authorized for ADP use. Aid code 7X continues to be authorized for ADP use. Bridging provides one month extended coverage while the case file information is transferred from the Medi-Cal program to the Healthy Families Program. - Added Aid Code OW-DHCS has advised that this code covers recipients formerly in aid code OP (a code authorized for ADP use) who no longer meet federal Breast and Cervical Cancer Treatment Program (BCCTP) requirements due to reaching age 65, are no longer in need of treatment for breast and/or cervical cancer, or have obtained creditable health coverage. Aid Recipients in aid code OW will continue to receive transitional full-scope Medi-Cal services until the county completes an eligibility determination for other Medi-Cal programs.
- Added Aid Code 2H-DHCS has advised that this code will cover blind individuals pursuant
 to Social Security Act Title XVI, who have not yet or cannot meet the Title II criteria for
 disability based on blindness. This aide code is derived from aid code 20, a code previously
 authorized for ADP use. Aid code 20 continues to be authorized for ADP use. For more

- Added Aid Code 5E-DHCS has advised of the establishment of this code for the Heal.thy
 Families to Presumptive Eligibility Program. This program replaced the former Healthy
 Families to Medi-Cal Bridge Program, discontinued on
 August 1, 2007. For the new Healthy Families to Medi-Cal Presumptive Eligibility Program,
 the Healthy Families to Medi-Cal Bridge Program referral process from Healthy Families to
 the counties will remain as it is now except that: 1) the child potentially eligible for Medi-Cal
 will be placed in aid code 5E instead of SE, and 2) Medi-Cal eligibility under 5E will continue
 until a Medi-Cal determination has been completed. For more detailed information on aid

- Removed Aid Codes 4P and 4R-The DHCS has advised that these codes are CalWORKs only and not Medi-Cal.
- Removed Aid Code 65-This aid code provided Medi-Cal coverage for Hurricane Katrina evacuees. The final date of eligibility for this code was May 31, 2006.
