PURPOSE

This bulletin clarifies the use of the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment (SAPT) Block Grant for Syringe Exchange Programs (SEPs). Currently, SAPT Block Grant funds may not be used for syringe exchange programs.

DISCUSSION

In 2009, Congress lifted the prohibition on federal funding of SEPs. In late 2011, Congress reinstituted the ban for Fiscal Year (FY) 2012. If this decision changes, ADP will notify counties.

BACKGROUND

On February 23, 2011, the Surgeon General, Regina Benjamin, M.D., M.B.A., determined that SEPs were effective in reducing drug use and transmission of HIV/AIDS. This determination lifted the ban against using federal dollars to fund SEPs. Congress reinstituted the ban in the FY 2012 Appropriations bill package.
