### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide County Alcohol and Drug Program Administrators copies of the various documents for submission of their FY 2001-02 Net Negotiated Net Amount and Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) cost reports.

### DISCUSSION

This will provide the counties approximately two months to complete the Cost Report Paradox diskette and return the cost report to the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs by **November 1, 2002**.
