PURPOSE

This bulletin clarifies the requirements and restrictions on the expenditure of State and federal funds allocated by the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) for alcohol and other drug (AOD) treatment and prevention services. The attached exhibit provides, by program, a hierarchy of the order in which funding for AOD treatment and prevention services should be expended. ADP is releasing this bulletin as a supplement to ADP bulletin 04-2, titled "Prohibition Regarding Supplantation of Funds."

DISCUSSION

In order to maintain the current level of federal funding, California is required to expend a specific amount of State General Fund (SGF) on AOD services. The significance of this maintenance of effort (MOE) requirement is magnified due to SGF reductions in recent years. Counties are receiving less State funding than in past years and must maximize funding to meet prevention and treatment needs. To meet the State's MOE requirement, SGF funds allocated to provide services for specific populations must be expended before using Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment (SAPT) Block Grant funds.

ADP would like to remind counties that the information included in this bulletin or its exhibits does not relieve counties of any monetary match requirements mandated by State or federal law. The Department cautions counties and providers that violating State and federal laws and regulations may jeopardize future AOD funding levels. Federal (SAPT Block Grant) law prohibits the supplantation of SGF with federal funds.

The attached exhibit provides a hierarchy for the expenditure of funding sources by program.
