SUBJECT: Adult Residential Treatment Services (ARTS) in Mental Health

Rehabilitation Centers (MHRCs): Exemption from Social Rehabilitation

Program Certification Requirements

PURPOSE: Provide notice of amendments to California Code of Regulations

(CCR), title 9, section 1840.332.

REFERENCE: Welfare and Institutions Code sections 5671, 5675, 10725, 14021.4,

14124.5, 14680, 14684 14700 and 14718.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Mental Health Rehabilitation Centers (MHRCs) are 24-hour programs, licensed by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Licensing and Certification Division, which provide intensive support and rehabilitation services designed to assist persons, 18 years or older, with mental disorders who would have been placed in a state hospital or

other mental health facility, to develop skills to become self-sufficient and capable of increasing levels of independent functioning.<sup>1</sup>

ARTS are rehabilitative services provided in a non-institutional, residential setting for Medi-Cal beneficiaries who would be at risk of hospitalization or other institutional placement if they were not in the residential treatment program.<sup>2</sup> ARTS activities may include, but are not limited to, assessment, plan development, therapy, rehabilitation and collateral.<sup>3</sup>

Prior to January 1, 2021, CCR, title 9, section 1840.332 required programs providing ARTS to be certified as a Social Rehabilitation Program (SRP) by DHCS and licensed as either a Social Rehabilitation Facility or Community Care Facility by the State Department of Social Services or licensed as a MHRC by DHCS to be eligible to claim Federal Financial Participation.<sup>4</sup>

## POLICY:

The amendments to CCR, title 9, section 1840.332 exempt MHRCs that provide ARTS from the requirement to obtain SRP certification from DHCS.

The amendments became effective on January 1, 2021.
