SUBJECT: County Contracts With Narcotic Treatment Programs and Cost

Reimbursement

PURPOSE: To remind counties of the reimbursement methodology for non-county

operated NTP providers participating in the Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) and to encourage DMC-ODS counties to accurately reflect that reimbursement methodology in contracts executed

with NTP providers.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Narcotic Treatment Program (NTP) providers have informed the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) that some counties include language in their contracts that indicate the NTP provider is reimbursed on a cost basis. When NTP providers are audited, sometimes by county auditors, the auditors ask for documentation regarding their costs, requiring NTP providers to explain that they are not reimbursed on a cost basis.

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## **POLICY:**

Non-county operated NTP reimbursement is <u>not</u> based on allowable costs. Rather, NTPs are reimbursed as the lower of the uniform statewide daily reimbursement rate or the provider's usual and customary charge for the same or similar services; see W&I Code, Section 14021.51(h); the Medi-Cal State Plan (Attachment 4.19-B, Pages 38-41f, Section B.2); and the DMC-ODS Intergovernmental Agreement (Exhibit B, Section J).

Each DMC-ODS Contractor must ensure that it is administering the relevant provisions under the DMC-ODS agreement ("Agreement") correctly with respect to non-county operated NTP providers.
