SUBJECT: Clarification Regarding the Submissions of Drug Medi-Cal Narcotic

Treatment Program (NTP) Cost Reports

PURPOSE: This Behavioral Health Information Notice (BHIN) provides clarification

to Drug Medi-Cal counties and certified Narcotic Treatment Programs (NTP) that counties must continue to submit NTP cost information for all their county operated and contracted NTP providers to DHCS by

November 1st of each year.

BACKGROUND

California Welfare and Institutions Code Section 14124.24(g)(1) requires all county and contracted NTP providers to submit a cost report by November 1st following the close of each fiscal year. The department recently issued BHIN 21-018 requiring county contracted NTP providers to submit NTP cost reports beginning with Fiscal Year 2019-20 directly to the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) using specific forms provided by the department.

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POLICY

Counties currently submit cost reports for county operated NTP providers and contracted NTP providers. DHCS has not changed this requirement. Counties must continue to submit NTP cost information for all their operated and contracted NTP providers by November 1st of each year.

<u>BHIN 21-018</u> added an additional requirement to county contracted NTP providers by requiring them to submit NTP cost reports directly to DHCS, but does not exempt counties from continuing to submit NTP cost information for all their county operated and contracted NTP providers.
