Subject: Termination of the California Outcomes Measurement Service for Prevention

This Information Notice informs counties and primary prevention service providers that the Department of Health Care Services, Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Program, Policy and Fiscal Division, Policy and Prevention Branch (PPFD-PPB) will terminate the California Outcomes Measurement Service for Prevention (CalOMS Pv) as of December 31, 2017.

SUD primary prevention data and the reporting capabilities contained in or associated with the CalOMS Pv system will not be accessible after December 31, 2017.

CalOMS Pv has been in existence since July 1, 2006. It was utilized by counties and primary prevention service providers to report primary prevention program and activity data as mandated in the State County Contract, Exhibit A, Attachment I, Program Specifications, Part I - Non-Drug Medi-Cal Substance Use Disorder Prevention and Treatment Services.

The termination of CalOMS Pv does not impact data collection or reporting within the CalOMS Treatment system. The two systems are not linked, and are completely separate from each other.

SUD primary prevention data for state fiscal year (SFY) 17-18 and beyond will be collected and reported in the Primary Prevention SUD Data Service, a replacement service for CalOMS Pv.

Prior to December 31, 2017, the CalOMS Pv expiration date, counties can run the following list of recommended standard reports for data archival purposes. Each county

should evaluate this list of reports, and determine if additional CalOMS Pv reports may be needed to fully archive county SUD primary prevention program and activity data. Reports should be run for SFY 13-14, 14-15, 15-16, and 16-17.
