SUBJECT: THRESHOLD LANGUAGES

Attached for your use is an updated threshold language data report for each county for the Fiscal Year 2004-2005. Counties are required to comply with all threshold language requirements contained in Title 9, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 1810.410 and Cultural Competence Plan Requirement (CCPR) contained in Information Notice No. 02-03.

“Threshold Language” means a language that has been identified as the primary language, as indicated on the Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System (MEDS), of 3,000 beneficiaries or five percent of the beneficiary population, whichever is lower, in an identified geographic area (Title 9, CCR, Section 1810.410(f)(13).
