SUBJECT: ORYX PARTICIPATION BY COMMUNITY BASED PSYCHIATRIC
HOSPITALS

We recently received a memorandum from the NASMHPD Research Institute regarding the ORYX Performance Measurement System which was approved by the JCAHO for state hospitals. At their last meeting, the ORYX Steering Committee recommended that community based psychiatric hospitals which provide public mental health inpatient services be invited to participate. A copy of the memorandum is enclosed.

Both Short-Doyle/Medi-Cal funded hospitals and those Fee-For-Service/Medi-Cal hospitals which have a contract with a Mental Health Plan are included in this invitation. We recommend the ORYX Performance Measurement System and encourage each county to act on this information as soon as possible.

As you are aware, the JCAHO has approved the NASMHPD Research Institute's (NRI) ORYX Performance Measurement System for state hospitals. To date, approximately 140 state hospitals have indicated their intent to participate.

During its recent meeting, the ORYX Steering Committee (composed of Commissioners Hogan, Selig, Sudders, Wilson, and Gorman) recommended that both for-profit and not-for-profit community based psychiatric hospitals be invited to participate only if the Commissioner indicates that such hospitals are considered to be a provider in the states' overall system of public mental health inpatient services. In many states, general hospitals with psychiatric units, county hospitals, and selected private hospitals have contracts with the state mental health agency or otherwise provide care for public patients paid by the state. Having these hospitals as part of the state's overall template of inpatient services both permits patients to remain in their own communities during treatment and potentially reduces the number of admissions to the state hospital.

This memo is to request your immediate assistance in determining which hospitals in your state you may wish to have included in the ORYX project, if such hospitals would be interested. We require immediate feedback from you to allow these hospitals sufficient time to review the technical requirements of our system and to enroll by the March deadline.

Two options are available for hearing from you:

1. Either forward us the hospital name, address, phone, and name of a contact persons. The NRI will then contact the hospital directly and discuss their ORYX participation; or

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2. Your office should contact the hospital directly and invite them to contact the NRI if they are interested in exploring ORYX participation with us.

In either case, once we have the information, we will provide necessary materials and technical assistance for the hospital to determine their participation with the NRI ORYX system.

Annual Fee

The Steering Committee and the NRI have established the per hospital rate at \$4,500 for the period January-December 1999. This same rate would be charged to community-based hospitals discussed above.
