- SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION AND MODIFICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH CONSUMER PERCEPTION SURVEY DATA COLLECTION
- REFERENCE: IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CONSUMER PERCEPTION SURVEY, WELFARE AND INSTITUTIONS CODE SECTION 5898 AND CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 9, SECTION 3530-40

DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH INFORMATION NOTICE NO.: 12-02

This Department of Mental Health (DMH) Information Notice provides clarification and guidance stipulated in DMH Information Notice Number 12-02, DMH Consumer Perception Survey (CPS) Data Collection, which provided guidance to Counties¹ for the submission of data for the CPS Data Collection requirement.

Due to numerous factors and logistical barriers, DMH is modifying the CPS data collection time period. The data collection for this survey will occur only once in FY 2012, and the time period for this collection will be conducted from August 20-24, 2012.

Completed August survey data must be submitted to the California Institute for Mental Health no later than September 7, 2012. DMH is still requiring that only the forms available on the DMH website are to be used for conducting the surveys. Any other tool/method, or forms that are modified in any way, will not be accepted. The procedures for data collection and reporting have not changed, and are as follows:

1. Visit the DMH website at <u>http://www.dmh.ca.gov/POQI/Documents.asp</u> to download each of the CPS forms. CPS Data Dictionaries are available on the

Information Technology Web Service (ITWS), Performance Outcomes and Quality Improvement (POQI) system, under the section POQI Information, Consumer Perception Survey (CPS) Data Dictionaries.

- 2. Conduct the survey during the collection period specified above, using the four types of forms available (Adult, Older Adult, Youth Family, and Youth). Each type of form is available in seven different languages (English, Spanish, Chinese, Russian, Vietnamese, Tagalog, and Hmong).
