1. 2101(f)-Like Children: Children under age 19 who were enrolled in Medicaid on 12/31/2013 and would otherwise become ineligible for Medicaid at their first redetermination using MAGI methodologies solely due to the loss of income disregards will remain Medicaid eligible until their next redetermination using MAGI methodologies.
2. Unmarried pregnant women who are not eligible under any other mandatory or optional categorically needy coverage group and who are either:
  - (a) under age 21 and living with her parent(s), and is not going to file a tax return for the taxable year, or
  - (b) under age 21 and is going to be claimed as a tax dependent by her parent(s) in the taxable year.
