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**Extend the Time Limited Proposition 56 Supplemental Payments for Family Planning, Access, Care and Treatment Program Services**

The Family Planning, Access, Care and Treatment (Family PACT) Program will continue to provide time-limited supplemental payments to Family PACT providers for Evaluation and Management (E&M) office visits rendered for comprehensive family planning services for the period of July 1, 2019 through December 31, 2021. These supplemental payments are equal to 150 percent of the payment amount determined based on the methodology described in Attachment 4.19-B, page 3g, last paragraph of the state plan for procedure codes 99201, 99202, 99203, 99204, 99211, 99212, 99213, and 99214.

Prop. 56 supplemental payments beginning in State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2019-20 will be made available for adjudicated claims once any necessary system edits to accommodate such payments have been implemented. Where applicable, subject claims received and paid prior to implementation of SFY 2019-20 system edits will be paid in accordance with SFY 2018-19 policy, and, upon implementation, will be retroactively reprocessed to accommodate any SFY 2019-20 changes.

These supplemental payments do not change the underlying payment amount for the E&M procedure codes noted in Attachment 4.19-B, Page 3g of the state plan.
