## PROPOSED STATE PLAN AMENDMENT TO EXTEND THE SUPPLEMENTAL REIMBURSEMENT FOR QUALIFIED PRIVATE HOSPITALS PROGRAM TO JUNE 30, 2022

This notice provides information of public interest regarding a proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS). Proposed SPA #21-0014 will extend the Supplemental Reimbursement for Qualified Private Hospitals Program (Program) to June 30, 2022. The continuation of this Program for an added year will allow for enhanced Medi-Cal payments to private hospitals and improve the availability of essential services for Medi-Cal beneficiaries. Additionally, DHCS is seeking to restructure payment amounts for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2021-22 to California State Plan, Attachment 4.19-A, Supplement 4, Section D.1 at page 10. Proposed SPA #21-0014 is necessary to allow Intergovernmental Transfer (IGT) funded payments for SFY 2021-22. Below are the proposed IGT payment amounts for SFY 2021-22:

The total pool remains at \$236,800,000 in State General Funds for SFY 2021-22. This is neither an increase nor decrease in the annual aggregate expenditure compared to the prior SFY.

The effective date of the proposed SPA is July 1, 2021. Proposed SPA # 21-0014 is subject to federal approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).
