DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES NOTICE OF GENERAL PUBLIC INTEREST RELEASE DATE: OCTOBER 3, 2022

THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES (DHCS) PROPOSES TO SUBMIT A STATE PLAN AMENDMENT (SPA) TO ADD DOULA SERVICES AND ESTABLISH A REIMBURSEMENT METHODOLOGY.

This notice provides information of public interest that DHCS proposes to submit SPA 22-0002 to the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to seek necessary approvals to add doula services as a covered Medi-Cal benefit and establish a reimbursement methodology. The effective date for SPA 22-0002 will be January 1, 2023.

DHCS proposes to add doula services to the list of preventive services pursuant to Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations Section 440.130(c), which must be recommended by a physician or other licensed practitioner of the healing arts within their scope of practice under state law. Doula services encompass the health education; advocacy; and physical, emotional, and nonmedical support provided before, during, and after childbirth or end of a pregnancy, including throughout the postpartum period. These services are aimed at preventing perinatal complications and improving health outcomes for birthing parents and infants. Doulas offer various types of support, including perinatal and labor support and guidance; health navigation; evidence-based education, including development of a birth plan; and linkages to community-based resources.

DHCS proposes to establish the Medi-Cal fee-for-service reimbursement rates for doula services based on existing Medi-Cal rates for similar services, as will be set on the December 31, 2022 fee schedule, and effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 2023.

These services would be available under both the fee-for-service (FFS) and managed care delivery system.

DHCS projects the overall fiscal impact to result in an aggregate expenditure increase of approximately \$1,334,000 in total funds (\$520,150 state general funds/\$813,850 federal funds) in state fiscal year 2022-23.

SPA 22-0002 is subject to approval by CMS.
