PROPOSED STATE PLAN AMENDMENT TO THE DISPROPORTIONATE SHARE HOSPITAL (DSH) MEDICAID SHORTFALL CALCULATION AND OTHER DSH TECHNICAL ADJUSTMENTS

This notice is to provide information of public interest about a proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS). The proposed SPA adjusts the methodology for the hospital-specific DSH limit calculation to conform to federal rules. The Medicaid Shortfall component of the hospital-specific DSH limit shall now only include costs and payments of services for which Medicaid is the primary payor. However, any hospital for which the most recent cost reporting period was in at least the 97th percentile of all hospitals, with respect to either the total number or percentage of inpatient days made of up patients entitled to both Medicare Part A and supplemental security income benefits, the hospitalspecific DSH limit calculation will be based on the previous methodology if it results in a higher value. This SPA also updates the title of the Medi-Cal cost reports to those currently used.

The proposed changes to the hospital-specific DSH limit should occur to reflect changes implemented by the Consolidate Appropriations Act of 2021. Moreover, the technical updates will ensure that the State Plan accurately reflects current terminology and reimbursement methodology.

DHCS estimates that the annual aggregate Medi-Cal expenditures for the DSH program will be budget neutral due to the proposed changes.

The effective date of the proposed SPA is July 1, 2022. All proposed SPAs are subject to approval by the Federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).
