California Department of Social Services (CDSS) Child Protection and Family Support Branch (CPFSB) Trauma-Informed System of Care

As part of the CDSS efforts for Continuum of Care Reform and inclusion of the Integrated Core Practice Model, the CPFSB is embarking on a project called Advancing California's Trauma-Informed Systems (ACTS). The purpose of this project is to identify gaps in Trauma-Informed Care and provide training and TA in county level systems. Some of the deliverables will include the following items:

- 1. Development of an environmental assessment for a trauma-informed system/organization to be used by local county agencies.
- 2. Development of trauma-informed care steering committees at the local county level.
- 3. Development of a toolkit to support all county-level systems seeking to advance traumainformed care practices.
- 4. Development of a trauma-informed care curriculum for county system partners.
- 5. Evaluation and continuous quality improvement efforts on the ACTS project.
