SUBJECT: Updates to forms relevant to quarterly reporting of involuntary and

voluntary treatment, conservatorships, and convulsive treatment and

psychosurgery data: DHCS 1008, 1009, 1010 and 1011.

BACKGROUND

W&I Code section 5402, subdivision (a) requires DHCS to collect quantitative data concerning the number of persons admitted and treated involuntarily. DHCS is also required to collect data related to the number of persons for whom temporary conservatorships and permanent conservatorships are established.

Furthermore, W&I Code section 5402, subdivision (b) states that each local mental health director shall provide the Department, upon its request, with any information, records, and reports that DHCS deems necessary for the purposes of section 5402.

In addition, W&I Code section 5326.15 requires counties to report quarterly data to DHCS related to the administration of convulsive treatments or psychosurgery.

Counties shall report quarterly data to the Department using the forms listed below. It is the responsibility of the county in which the treatment facility is located to include all of the relevant information about the patients treated in the facility in its report. This includes data from all facilities, public or private, and the persons served in those facilities receiving services reimbursed by private or public funds. DHCS requires that counties collect and report the data, since the counties are responsible for certifying the facilities that serve persons on an involuntary basis.

It is important to note that it is not the responsibility of the county from which the patient originated to report the data related to the patient, it is the responsibility of the county where the patient has been taken for treatment.

POLICY

DHCS has updated the forms enumerated below for reporting data related to persons detained in jail facilities, conservatorship data, involuntary treatment data, and convulsive treatment and psychosurgery data.

Reports are due to the Department by the 30th of the month following the end of each quarter. Please begin using the updated forms effective immediately for the October 1, 2021 – December 31, 2022, Fiscal Year 2021/2022.

- DHCS 1008 Quarterly Report for Services Provided to Persons Detained in Jail Facilities (Admissions);
- DHCS 1009 Quarterly Report of Conservatorships established by the Superior Court of the County;

DHCS 1010 – Quarterly Report on Involuntary Treatment; and,

 DHCS 1011 – Quarterly Report for Convulsive Treatments and Psychosurgery Administered.
