

County Compassionate Release Program (CCRP) County Medical Probation Program (CMPP)

Inmate receives healthcare services at a Medi-Cal provider
(Aid Codes: J1, J2, J3, J4, J5, J6, J7, J8, K6, K7, K8, K9).

Provider submits claim to the Department of Health Care Services' (DHCS) Fiscal Intermediary (FI) consistent with standard Medi-Cal claiming (Inpatient, Inpatient Mental Health, and Inpatient Physician, Outpatient).

DHCS' FI suspends the claim and confirms if the county of responsibility is participating in the Medi-Cal County Inmate Program (MCIP).

Participating County

DHCS' FI adjudicates claim and pays the provider the appropriate Medi-Cal rate.

DHCS' Safety Net Financing Division (SNFD) recoups the nonfederal share of the provided medical service on a quarterly basis.

Non-Participating County

DHCS' FI denies the claim and sends the provider a denial message.

The county is responsible for arranging and paying for medical care for its inmate.
