# **DHCS - Fiscal Intermediary (FI) Updates**

## 3) Beneficiaries with Unsatisfactory Immigration Status (UIS)

- System Development Notice (SDN) 21051 was implemented on June 20, 2022, to deny payments for services rendered to UIS beneficiaries.
- The effective date for this policy is July 16, 2021, per Policy and Procedure Letter (PPL) 21-015.
- An LEA's Remittance Advice Detail (RAD) report will show denied claims with the RAD code "9908", "Recipient not eligible for Federal Financial Participation (FFP)."
- An Erroneous Payment Correction (EPC) will be forthcoming to recoup erroneously paid claims associated with UIS beneficiaries, starting with claims that have a date of service on or after July 16, 2021.

# 4) Screening for Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs)

- Two new procedure codes (G9919 and G9920) have been added to the FI system to allow billing for ACEs Screenings, effective for dates of service on or after July 1, 2022.
- FI updates were implemented on September 26, 2022.
- LEAs may now submit claims using G9919 and G9920.
- Practitioners who bill Medi-Cal for ACEs screenings must complete a certified ACEs Aware Core Training. This free, two-hour online training certifies eligible clinicians to receive Medi-Cal payment for ACEs screenings. - LEA BOP Provider Manual updates related to the new procedure codes were implemented on September 16, 2022.

# 5) COVID-19 Vaccine Counseling Modifier

- COVID-19 counseling claims may now be billed using the "CR" modifier with CPT code 99401. Reimbursement will be limited to one unit of service.
- LEAs may bill COVID-19 counseling claims back to dates of service on or after July 1, 2021.
- DHCS has established a <u>one quarter timeliness extension</u>, allowing claims with dates of service from July 1, 2021, to September 30, 2021, to be adjudicated until October 31, 2022.
- Claims with dates of service on or after October 1, 2022 are subject to the standard 12-month billing timeliness requirements.
- LEA BOP Provider Manual updates related to COVID-19 counseling services were implemented on September 16, 2022.

# 6) Post-Partum Benefit Expansion

- Aid code 76 will be eligible for reimbursement for LEA BOP services effective April 1, 2022.
- DHCS has initiated an EPC to reimburse claims erroneously denied between April 1, 2022, and the system implementation date of August 22, 2022. The EPC is expected to implement later this fall.

# 7) Associate Marriage and Family Therapist (AMFT)/Registered Associate Clinical Social Worker (ACSW) Expansion of Covered Services

- Expansion is effective July 1, 2021, allowing AMFTs and ACSWs to be reimbursed for psychosocial status assessments and health education/anticipatory guidance services provided that all applicable supervisory requirements have been met.
- FI updates to add the HM and HL modifiers to existing CPT codes were implemented on June 21, 2022.
- An EPC has been completed for approximately \$130, impacting two LEAs that submitted historical claims related to the AMFT/ACSW expansion.

## 8) SFY 2022-23 Rate Inflation

- Inflation rates for SFY 2022-23 have been implemented in the claims processing system and are included in the LEA BOP Provider Manual.
- An EPC has been completed for approximately \$575, impacting a small number of LEAs that submitted claims with dates of service between July 1, 2022, and July 25, 2022, when the system updates were completed.

  - <u>All</u> LEAs must submit an Annual Report.
  - Reporting for current and previous fiscal year.
  - LEAs may use the AR to update their information, such as the LEA's official name, mailing address, and EIN number.
  - Must be submitted electronically (with digital signature) to: <u>LEA.AnnualReport@dhcs.ca.gov</u>.
  - Due by Wednesday, November 30, 2022.
