



Specialty Mental Health Service Providers (SMHS) changes to Enrollment Requirements

Legal Authority

- The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) provides Specialty Mental Health Services (SMHS) through a 1915(b) waiver. According to the approved waiver, DHCS employs the Prepaid Inpatient Health Plan (PIHP) model as the delivery system for SMHS.
- Title 42, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 438.2 defines a PIHP as a managed care entity making it subject to the rules contained in Title 42, Part 438
- Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' (CMS) Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program Managed Care Final Rule CMS-2390-F, dated May 6, 2016.
- 21st Century Cures Act (Cures Act), dated December 13, 2016.



Enrollment Requirement

- Currently, individual staff and facility providers are not required to enroll in Fee-For-Service Medi-Cal.
- However, with the implementation of the Cures Act, 42 CFR, Section 438.602(b) now requires states to screen, enroll, and periodically revalidate, all network providers of managed care organizations, prepaid inpatient health plans, and prepaid ambulatory health plans, aligning them with the Fee-For-Service (FFS) enrollment requirements. This includes Mental Health Plan (MHP) network providers.
- Title 42 of the CFR, Part 455, Subparts B and E set forth the disclosure, provider screening and enrollment requirements for FFS Medi-Cal providers.
- These requirements must be adhered to by managed care plan network providers if that provider is a provider type enrolled by the FFS Medi-Cal program. This includes Mental Health Plans.
- The Medicaid Provider Enrollment Compendium (MPEC) dated July 24, 2018, clarified that only managed care plan providers that can enroll in FFS Medi-Cal are required to enroll.

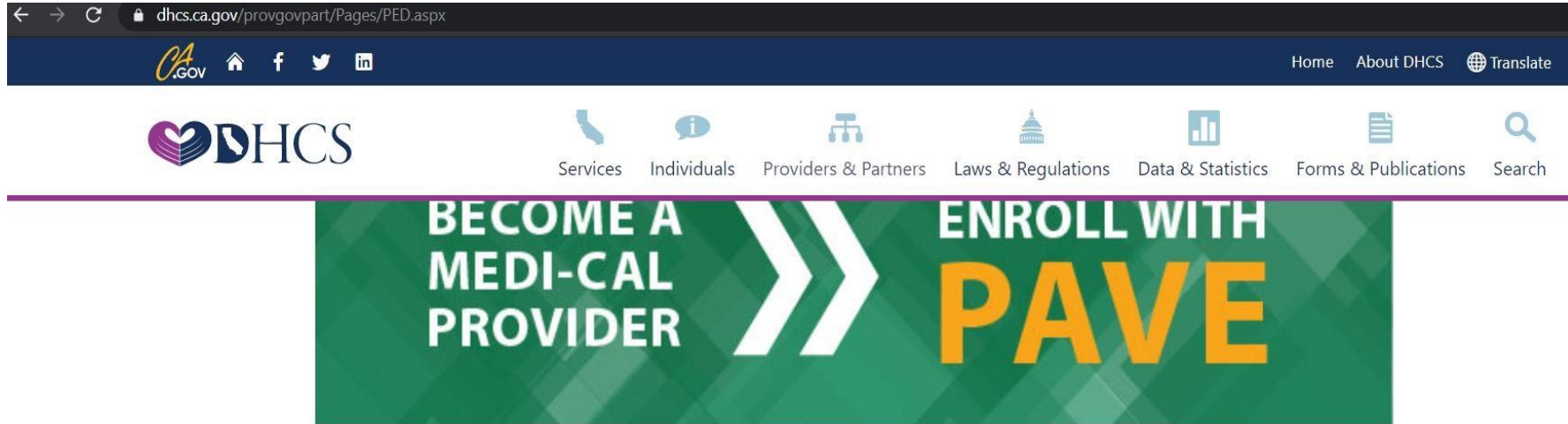


Open Data Portal

- The CHHS Open Data Portal allows you to enter the name of any provider to check to see if they are enrolled and it will allow you to view their effective date of enrollment. The information on Open Data Portal is updated monthly.
- If the provider is enrolled no additional action is required by you. However, if the provider is not enrolled and is a provider type required to be enrolled you are required to submit an application in PAVE.

Provider Enrollment Division

Provider Enrollment Division (PED) is responsible for the enrollment and re-enrollment of fee-for-service health care service providers into the Medi-Cal program. There are approximately 182,000 Medi-Cal providers who serve the medically necessary needs of the Medi-Cal population. PED is also responsible for developing enrollment policy, and updating and maintaining provider information in the Provider Master File database that is used in the claims payment process. The dataset provides basic information about Fee-for-Service (FFS) providers enrolled in the Medi-Cal program, including providers enrolled as Non-physician Medical Practitioners (NMP) and Ordering, Referring and Prescribing (ORP) providers. The information is based on a point in time and is expected to be updated monthly. The data were retrieved from the Provider Master File (PMF), which has been used in the claims payment process and is maintained by the Provider Enrollment Division (PED). The variables in the dataset include provider number, name, type, specialty, geographic information, etc. DHCS does not collect information on whether or not fee-for-services providers accept new Medi-Cal patients, and this dataset does not include Managed Care providers.
