



November MLTSS and Duals Integration Workgroup Meeting Summary

On November 17, 2022, the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) hosted the November Managed Long-Term Services and Supports (MTLSS) & Duals Integration Workgroup.

The meeting began with Anastasia Dodson, Deputy Director of the DHCS Office of Medicare Innovation and Integration (OMII), reviewing a number of policies launching in January 2023 that affect dual eligible beneficiaries, such as the transition from Cal MediConnect (CMC) to Medicare Medi-Cal Plans (Medi-Medi Plans or MMPs), the Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan (D-SNP) Look-alike Transition, transition (CalAIM Medi-Cal Managed Care Enrollment for Dual Eligible Beneficiaries and the CalAIM Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) Long-Term Care (LTC) Carve-In. Anastasia also provided an update on the Transition Noticing Timelines and the Outreach and Resources now available for Medi-Medi Plans. During the January 2023 Enrollment Changes section, Paul Nguyen and Ivana Thompson with the Pharmacy Benefits Division (PBD) at DHCS joined the meeting to provide a brief overview of transitioning the Cal MediConnect pharmacy benefit to Medi-Cal Rx.

Following the presentations, stakeholders asked questions about the various enrollment changes occurring January 2023, such as the LTC Carve-In. During the next section of the workgroup, Anastasia shared an update on the 2023 CalAIM D-SNP Policy Guide and 2024 SMAC Development. Then Lindsey Wilson, Assistant Division Chief with the Third-Party Liability and Recovery Division (TPLRD) at DHCS provided a reminder about the Crossover Claims and Balance Billing Policy for dual eligible beneficiaries.

Anastasia concluded the meeting by sharing information about the upcoming topics for the MLTSS & Duals Integration Workgroup meetings. Following each topic, stakeholders were given the opportunity to ask questions and provide comments. The recording and transcript of the November MLTSS and Duals Integration Workgroup meeting contain additional information about the presentation and discussion.
