 Proposition 56 supplemental payment suspension date lifted

CalAIM New Benefits

- Caries Risk Assessment (CRA)
 - Bundled with nutritional counseling
- Silver diamine fluoride (SDF)



CalAIM Pay for Performance

 Increase preventive services utilization for all Medi-Cal members.

 Establish and maintain continuity of care through a dental home.



 The July 2021 payment of \$2 million was released on August 2, 2021, which brings the total payment to \$249.7 million.

 As of July 2021, 258 safety net clinics (SNC) are participating in Domain 1.



 As of July 2021, DHCS has paid approximately \$183.1 million for Domain 2.

 As of July 2021, 3,357 rendering providers have received payments for Domain 2. This reflects a growth of 6.6 percent in providers since February 2021.



 The June 2021 payment of \$73.5 million was released in July 2021.

 As of July 2021, 123 SNCs are participating in Domain 3.



- As of December 31, 2020, all 13 Local Dental Pilot Projects have concluded operations and are currently in the administrative closeout phase. All remaining invoices have been received and paid.
- As of July 2021, DHCS has issued \$108.5 million for Domain 4.



Proposition 56 Supplemental Payments

FY 2019-20

 As of June 30, 2021, FFS payments were \$363 million and DMC payments were \$25.5 million.

FY 2020-21

• As of June 30, 2021, FFS payments were \$391.9 million and DMC payments were \$21.5 million.



Proposition 56 CalHealthCares Loan Repayment

- Cohort 3 (June 2021) \$10,400,964 million in student loans was awarded to 44 dentists, which represents five specialties and serves 20 counties.
- To date, approximately \$201 million has been awarded to physicians and dentists. A total of \$340 million has been allocated to CalHealthCares.
- The next application for the CalHealthCares program will launch in early 2022, and awardees will be notified in June.
