Housing and Homeless Incentive Program

MCP Resource Guide February 2022

In accordance with the <u>Home and Community Based Services Spending Plan</u>, the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is implementing the Housing and Homeless Incentive Program (HHIP) from January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2023. HHIP aims to improve health outcomes and access to whole person care services by addressing housing insecurity and instability as a social determinant of health for the Medi-Cal population. The goals of HHIP are to:

- 1. Reduce and prevent homelessness; and,
- 2. Ensure Medi-Cal managed care plans (MCPs) develop the necessary capacity and partnerships to connect their members to needed housing services.

Recommende	Steps for MCPs
February	. Review available state housing funds and programs and recommended strategies for health care stakeholder to address homelessness ^{1,2}
March	 Complete the HHIP Letter of Intent (due March 25, 2022) Connect with local housing agencies in your service area – including Continuums of Care (CoCs) – to learn about their existing efforts and current needs and engage with HHAP Round 3 applicants ^{3,4}
April	 Invite housing and HHAP stakeholders to participate in developing your Local Homelessness Plan for HHIP development process
Мау	 Expand partnerships with housing agencies and HHAP leads in your service area
June	 Submit one Local Homelessness Plan (LHP) per county to DHCS (due June 30, 2022)
