The purpose of this All Plan Letter serves as a reminder to the Sacramento GMC plans and LA PHP plans that plans are responsible for all in-area and out-of-area dental emergency services pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 14454. Moreover, in accordance with Title (tit.) 22 California Code of Regulations (Cal. Code Regs.) section 53216 and tit. 28 Cal. Code Regs. section 1300.67(g), emergency dental services are to be covered by the plans for reimbursement. Furthermore, under the terms of the GMC plan and PHP contracts, such emergency dental services are to be covered by the plans for reimbursement without prior authorization pursuant to Exhibit A, Attachment 10, section G.1. and Exhibit A, Attachment 11, D.

Reimbursements for emergency services are also extended to non-contracted providers; see Exhibit A, Attachment 10, section G.1. The non-contracting provider treating the Member's condition is responsible for determining the extent of treatment necessary to sufficiently stabilize and permit referral. The determination is also binding on the plan. Plans shall ensure emergency services are available and accessible within the service areas 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
