SUBJECT: Managed Care Plan County Model Change Update

PURPOSE: To provide an update on the status of the Managed Care Plan County Model

Change Letter of Intent submissions

SUMMARY:

The following counties received a **Conditional Approval** from DHCS to move forward with their request to change the Managed Care Plan Model type that currently operates in the County. A conditional approval allows the county and Managed Care Plan to move on to the next steps in the Managed Care Plan County Model Change process. The next steps require the County to submit to the DHCS an approved County Ordinance by October 10, 2021 indicating the change In addition, by December 3-2021, Plans are required to submit their <u>Network Contracting</u> <u>Strategy</u> which will be considered part of the Plan Operational Readiness assessment.
