CDPH Updates (Miren Klein)

- Vaccine Updates
 - 1. We have 12.6 million administered doses and 4.2 million people are fully vaccinated
 - 2. Information on vaccines and also a dashboard on vaccinations can be found here
 - 3. Eligibility for new individuals beginning this week, guidance is posted on website
 - 16-64 with high risk conditions
 - Individuals in congregate living settings
 - Public Transit Workers
 - Additional 4.4 million Californians are now eligible
 - Verification document on type of condition is not required but when you make an appointment you must sign a self-attestation.
 - 4. National supply of the vaccine still very low. People with high risk conditions are advised to first reach out to their health care providers.
 - All adults may be eligible to receive a vaccine starting May 1, according to Biden administration, but we are still waiting on more guidance. We expect our supply of vaccines to increase in April.
 - 6. Federal retail partnerships are prioritizing childcare providers and educators for the month of March.
