How to Qualify for Hearing Aid Coverage

The Hearing Aid Coverage for Children Program (HACCP) is currently available to children under 18 without insurance or whose insurance does not cover hearing aids and related services. Beginning in January 2023, HACCP eligibility will be expanded to youth up to age 21, as well as to children/youth with partial other health coverage up to \$1,500 for hearing aids. Applying for HACCP is as easy as 1, 2, 3:

- **1.** Obtain provider referral for hearing aids/evaluation
- 2. Provide proof of income eligibility (chart to the right)
- **3.** Provide proof that you have no other health coverage for hearing aids

HACCP covers hearing aids and hearing aid replacement (including externally worn bone conduction hearing aids), hearing aid supplies/accessories (including ear molds), hearing aid-related audiology services, and other related post-evaluation services.

» It is NOT required to be denied by CCS before applying to HACCP.

» Children can qualify for HACCP regardless of immigration status.
