This Information Notice is to remind Mental Health Plans (MHPs) that the due date for submitting the Short-Doyle/Medi-Cal Cost Report is December 31 following the close of every fiscal year. The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) posts a MHSUDS Information Notice on cost report policy annually with detailed instructions on uploading the initial cost report. Within ten days after the initial cost report submittal, the MHP is required to send to DHCS a hard copy of the county Detailed and Summary cost reports and the original certification.

DHCS may approve an extension on a case-by-case basis to a MHP in need of extra time for the cost report submission; per Welfare & Institutions Code (W&I) § 14705(c), and/or guidelines established by the Department. Please contact your CRFS analyst at least two weeks prior to the due date for a 30-day extension request form.

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Whenever DHCS determines that a MHP has failed to comply with the submission requirements, DHCS is required to notify the MHP in writing within 30 days of its determination. This notification will request the MHP to comply with the provisions set forth in W&I § 14712(e).
