SUBJECT: REWRITE OF THE CLIENT AND SERVICES INFORMATION SYSTEM

COMPLETE

The purpose of this Information Notice is to inform counties, who report data to the Client and Services Information (CSI) system, that the CSI system has been updated and migrated to a new system platform; and that DHCS will be hosting training webinars in the near future.

The migration process to the new system platform is referred to as the "CSI Rewrite". The CSI Rewrite was completed and went live on April 25, 2016. Information about the migration of the CSI system was first released on March 17, 2016 in MHSUDS Information Notice 16-010. The CSI system is now accessible through a new system platform, which is called the Behavioral Health Information System (BHIS). All of the legacy data from the old system was also migrated and is accessible through the new BHIS portal. As of April 25, 2016, all CSI data submissions must be done through the BHIS portal; CSI data can no longer be uploaded through the Information Technology Web System (ITWS) portal.
