- SUBJECT: MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ACT REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-15 – PREVENTION AND EARLY INTERVENTION STATEWIDE PROGRAMS
- REFERENCE: WELFARE AND INSTITUTIONS CODE SECTION 5899 AND CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 9, SECTION 3510

This Information Notice is to notify counties of Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-15 changes to reporting processes specified in MHSUDS Information Notice 15-038, which requires counties to report Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Statewide Program expenditures annually on the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Revenue and Expenditure Report (RER). These changes <u>only</u> apply to counties that have assigned PEI Statewide Program funds to the California Mental Health Authority (CalMHSA) joint powers authority (JPA). Counties that maintain their PEI Statewide Program funds locally and are not part of the CalMHSA JPA must continue to report expenditures on the RER.

Counties are not to report expenditures of funds assigned to CalMHSA for PEI Statewide Programs on the RER as this information will be reported in CalMHSA's FY 2014-15 annual funding statement, which will be released in Spring 2016.

DHCS will compile the expenditure information collected through the FY 2014-15 RERs and CalMHSA's FY 2014-15 funding statement to develop the MHSA County Expenditures by Component during FY 2014-15 report.

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As specified in Title 9, California Code of Regulations, Section 3510, the RER is to be submitted no later than December 31, 2015.
