The purpose of this bulletin is to notify all stakeholders of the information technology (IT) changes that will take place as a result of the transfer of the Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) Program from the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) to the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS):

As part of the Fiscal Year 2011-12 budget process, Governor Brown signed Assembly Bill (AB) 106 (Chapter 32, Statutes of 2011), which enacted law to transfer the administration of the Drug Medi-Cal Treatment Program and applicable federal Medicaid functions from ADP to DHCS, effective July 1, 2012.

Stakeholders in the bill include clients, providers, counties, representatives of the Legislature and the Federal Government. In addition to incorporating stakeholder input, DHCS and ADP must guide the transfer of functions in a manner that results in no unintended interruptions in service delivery to clients.

With the DMC Program transition to DHCS effective July 1, 2012, the URL to access ITWS for submission of DMC billing data and California Outcomes Measurement System (CalOMS Tx) Treatment data reporting for all clients will be changed.

The new URL, <https://itws.dhcs.ca.gov>, should be bookmarked by the users. Initially, all network services will be automatically re-directed to the appropriate DHCS URL.

NOTE: The ITWS System will be taken off-line, and be unavailable to all users July 1-3, 2012, for system conversion. We regret any inconvenience this may cause.

CalOMS Tx-ITWS

- The ITWS system will be moved from its current physical location at the Department of Mental Health (DMH) to DHCS, on July 1, 2012.
- The link (URL) to log into the ITWS will change to <https://itws.dhcs.ca.gov>. The user will be automatically directed to the new ITWS page at DHCS.
- After the transition from July 1st to the 3rd, ADP does not expect any break in service for users to sign on and upload their CalOMS Tx data.

DMC Claims

- The ITWS system will be moved from its current physical location at DMH to DHCS, on July 1, 2012.
- The link (URL) to log into the ITWS will change to <https://itws.dhcs.ca.gov>. The user will be automatically directed to the new ITWS page at DHCS. The ADP Short/Doyle Medi-Cal Phase II 5010 Companion Guide will be updated to reflect the new URL for DMC claim submission.
- After the transition from July 1st to the 3rd, ADP does not expect any break in service for users to sign on and upload their DMC Billing data to the State, using their already assigned user ID and passwords.
