SUBJECT: California Children's Services COVID Flexibilities Ending on

December 31, 2021

The purpose of this Information Notice is to advise county California Children's Services (CCS) programs that effective December 31, 2021, the following COVID flexibility ended:

• Public health nurses (PHNs) – flexibility to temporarily reassign PHNs to assist with county COVID activities and vaccine administration.

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Integrated Systems of Care (ISCD) supports the full and safe reopening of the state, while ensuring CCS clients are able to safely and timely access their medically necessary services. Although California reopened on June 15, 2021, DHCS continued this flexibility to allow CCS programs additional time to prepare for a December 31, 2021 end date. DHCS believes this flexibility can now be safely ended since PHNs are no longer needed to perform county COVID related activities.

As noted on the CCS COVID guidance issued on December 22, 2020, all other flexibilities will continue until the federal public health emergency has been lifted on April 16, 2022, pending extension by the federal government.¹ For a complete list of the CCS program flexibilities, please visit the CCS webpage.
