MEDICAL THERAPY UNIT (MTU) MEDI-CAL REIMBURSEMENT STATE SUBJECT: COUNTY COST SHARING AND RECONCILIATION The purpose of this Numbered Letter (NL.) is to provide information on State policy regarding reimbursement for MT U services by the Medi-Cal program and State/county cost sharing of such reimbursements.

## Background

N.L.: 03-0104, changed the methodology for State county cost sharing of reimbursements received from Medi-Cal for MTU services provided to CCS clients beginning July 1, 2004. Counties were instructed that Medi-Cal reimbursements should offset a county's Medical Therapy Program (MTP) expenditures prior to determining the State and county share of those costs pursuant to Section 123940 of the Health and Safety Code.

## Policy

The Department has determined that the cost sharing methodology implemented by NL. 03-0104, which provided 50/50 sharing of the MTU Medi-Cal reimbursement between the State and the counties, is incorrect. The Department must revert to the methodology that was in effect prior to July 1, 2003.

In order for the State to share equally with the counties in the savings accruing from billing Medi-Cal for MTU services provided to Medi-Cal beneficiaries, retroactive to July 1, 2004, the State will offset the entire General Fund portion and one half of the federal portion of Medi-Cal payments made for MTP services.

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## **Implementation**

The methodology that was in effect prior to July 1, 2003, will be reinstated effective July 1, 2004. This will once again provide a 75/25 distribution of the MTU Medi-Cal reimbursement between the state and the counties. Reimbursements for MTU services paid by Medi-Cal for the first three quarters of Fiscal Year 2004-05 will be adjusted and incorporated into the Fourth Quarter Report of Actual MTU Services Paid by Medi-Cal.
