CHDP Medical Record Review Tool

Summary of Changes

Aside from grammatical and technical edits, the following summarizes the changes in this revision of the CHDP Medical Record Review tool:

Presentation

 The Medical Record Review Tool and the Medical Record Review Guidelines have been combined into one document titled: Child Health and Disability Prevention Program Medical Record Review (DHCS 4492)

Directions for Scoring

- Clarification and further detail regarding Critical Elements
- Revision of the total per chart from 139 to 140. The additional point originated in "Documentation Criteria 2.E. The expected total for a 5-chart review will be 700 and a 10-chart review total will be 1400.
- Maximum point can be awarded was changed from 4 to 3 points.
- "Line Item" to "Critical Element" wording for consistency within the scoring instructions. The "Optional per local county determination" was deleted per today's meeting recommendation and group acceptance.
- CE definition to reflect a positive approach and to consider eligible charts only in cases of age specific CEs.

Scoring Summary

- Prepopulated and no populated expected points versions are provided.
- Revised "Line item" to "Critical Element" for consistency with the scoring instructions.
- Further detail regarding Line Items
- Lead Criterion (4.K.): "counselling" word updated to "anticipatory guidance"; removed "Risk assessment: 6m, 9m, 18m, 3y, 4y, 5y, 6y and based on universal screening requirements", and updated with "Anticipatory guidance 6 -72 months. Lead screening required 12m, 24m. 24 months to 72 months, for children not tested at 24 months or later" with reference to CCR Title 17 Chapter 9 Article 2 section 37100 (Screening for Childhood Lead Poisoning).
