SUBJECT: CHILD HEALTH AND DISABILITY PREVENTION PROGRAM

DISCONTINUANCE

The purpose of this notice is to inform Child Health and Disability Prevention (CHDP) providers about the discontinuance of the CHDP Program effective July 1, 2024. Detailed information can be found in <u>Senate Bill 184: Health</u>.

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has initiated a stakeholder engagement process to inform the development of a transition plan and define milestones to guide the transition of CHDP activities to other Medi-Cal delivery systems or services. Details regarding the transition will be posted on the CHDP Transition webpage (<a href="www.dhcs.ca.gov/services/chdp/pages/chdp-transition.aspx">www.dhcs.ca.gov/services/chdp/pages/chdp-transition.aspx</a>) as they become available. DHCS will also provide regular updates to County CHDP programs during quarterly CHDP Executive Committee meetings.

The CHDP Gateway will continue as "Children's Presumptive Eligibility Program (CPE)". All active CHDP providers as of June 30, 2024 will be automatically enrolled as CPE providers on July 1, 2024. To maintain active provider status, CHDP providers must continue to meet the monitoring and oversight requirements of the local CHDP Program in their jurisdiction. CHDP providers that are not active as of June 30, 2024 must complete steps to meet eligibility requirements that will be defined in the transition planning process.
