REGIONAL ASSOCIATIONS

- Purpose

- To promote coordination and cooperation among the Child Health and Disability Prevention programs within each region
- To consider issues and policies of mutual concern
- To forward questions and/or recommend appropriate action to the State Child Health and Disability Prevention Program through the Executive Committee

- Four (4) Regional Associations:

- Bay Area, Central, North, South
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- ❑ Membership includes Child Health and Disability Prevention Directors and Deputy Directors. Other local program staff may attend as invited.
 - ❑ Regional Associations may establish subcommittees, for example:
 - ❑ foster care
 - ❑ health education
 - ❑ provider relations
 - ❑ oral health
 - ❑ Each Subcommittee shall designate a representative to attend the Regional Association meetings.
 - ❑ State Children's Medical Services Staff attend Regional Association meetings to provide input and expertise.
