#### **Summary of Evidence**

Individuals living at A Place for Seniors LLC have limited opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community. Individuals can only participate in community activities with family or friends. Staff with A Place for Seniors do not support individuals when they leave their home except for medical appointments. A Place for Seniors assists individuals with transportation only for medical appointments. Individuals are not supported to participate in community activities with or separate from their housemates/roommates as A Place for Seniors does not schedule community activities as a part of its plan for service or support individuals to participate in integrated community activities like senior centers or adult day programs. A Place for Seniors has practices that impede on an individual's ability to access the community including requiring individuals to sign out, house rules that require individuals to be in bed at 9 pm and having locked and alarmed doors to which individuals do not have keys.

#### **Summary of** Remediation Strategy

A Place for Seniors submitted a Remediation Work Plan (RWP) that aims to increase opportunities for individuals to interact in and with the broader community. A Place for Seniors intends to provide transportation to individuals for their medical appointments, community outings and other events or simply to run errands. A Place for Seniors said they will plan individual and group activities outside the home during weekly meetings with staff and individuals. Staff will provide transportation for individual and group activities in the community. The staff at A Place for Seniors will assist individuals to find applicable resources for integrated community engagement and employment. In addition to talking about these opportunities during weekly meetings, individuals will have access to flyers, brochures, and newspapers. In the RWP, A Place for Seniors said staff members are available to assist as needed, including assisting individuals in the community.



A Place for Seniors explained that staff ask individuals to sign in and out so that they have a general idea when the individual will return. The purpose is to know who is in the home and when individuals are planning to return. A Place for Senior said that individuals choose their own routines for when they want to go to bed and are not required to be in bed at a certain time. A Place for Seniors said the doors and gates are locked but individuals have keys/pin codes and can come and go as desired. They intend to discontinue to the use of alarms by November of 2022.
