Due to the design or model of service provision in the setting, individuals have limited, if any, opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community, including individuals not receiving Medicaid-funded HCBS

Summary of Evidence	 Individuals living at Cross Creek Cottage have limited opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community. Cross Creek Cottage relies on family for community access. They do not facilitate or support community integration. Cross Creek Cottage does not usually provide transportation and individuals who require support when in the community rely on family or friends for transportation. They do not plan community activities as part of its plan for service. Individuals do not have the opportunity to participate in community activities individually or with others with whom they live. Doors to the home are locked and alarmed and individuals do not have keys. Individuals must sign in and out when they leave.
Summary of Remediation Strategy	Cross Creek Cottage has submitted a plan to remediate the noncompliance. Cross Creek Cottage provides transportation for individuals to medical and non-medical activities in the community. Individuals may have transportation from Cross Creek Cottage or use third party or public transportation. Individuals who go to the senior center have bus passes. Individuals are supported to plan activities, participate in field trips, outings, and shopping trips. Some activities
	are planned by Cross Creek Cottage staff with individuals. They plan more activities during warmer months. When individuals want to go out individually or with others, Cross Creek Cottage staff assist the individual. For example, individuals may go out individually with staff to shop for clothes or they may go out with others to shop and eat at the local market and café. Staff will assist with transportation or other supports as needed. Cross Creek Cottage no longer has locked gates or doors that limit individuals' freedom of movement.
	Individuals can open doors and gates without a key. The doors have chimes that ring when the door opens but stops when the door is closed. Cross Creek Cottage will develop a policy that describes the use of the chimes explaining that will be reviewed with individuals at admission and during planning meetings. Individuals are no longer required to sign in and out when they go out and return to their home.
