Due to the design or model of service provision in the setting, individuals have limited, if any, opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community, including individuals not receiving Medicaid-funded HCBS

Summary of Evidence	Individuals living at Holy Hill Home Care have limited opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community. Holy Hill Home Care relies on families for transportation to activities in the community. Holy Hill Home Care does not schedule community activities as part of its plan for services for individuals or groups. Individuals are not provided information about services available to them in the broader community or supported to participate in integrated community activities. Individuals are restricted from interacting independently in the community.
Summary of Remediation Strategy	Holy Hill Home Care submitted a Remediation Work Plan (RWP) that described how they would support individuals to have opportunities for interaction with and in the broader community. Holy Hill Home Care intends to support individuals to have transportation so they can participate in community activities. Holy Hill Home Care says they will provide information regarding public and private transportation. If an individual wants or needs assistance to set up transportation, the staff will assist. If an individual is not able to access the community independently, Holy Hill Home Care staff will be available to accompany the individual. Any limitations or restrictions to accessing the community independently will be based on assessed needs and documented in the person-centered plan. The person-centered plan and any restrictions are reviewed at least annually.  Holy Hill Home Care will arrange and support community activities for individuals and groups. The person-centered team, including the physician, will assess an individual's needs and preferences at admission and at least annually after that. The outcome of the assessment will be documented in the person-centered plan. The staff will arrange



transportation and supervision as needed to meet the needs and preferences of individuals and as documented in their person-centered plans.

Individuals will be supported to learn about services in the broader community and participate in integrated community activities, such as a senior center or adult day programs based on an assessment of the individual's needs and preferences. The staff will learn about individuals' interests, needs, preferences, and abilities during conversations at admission and at least annually. Based on those conversations, the staff will provide information about services available in the broader community including senior centers and adult day programs. When the individual wants to participate in a senior center or adult day program, the staff will provide the needed supports as defined in the person-centered plan.
