Summary of Evidence	Individuals at La Palma Royale have limited opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community. Entry/exit from the doors are locked. There are individuals from others living at La Palma Royale. Individuals do not participate in activities with other people living at La Palma Royale. There is a separate activity calendar. Individuals
Summary of Remediation Strategy	In the Remediation Work Plan, La Palma Royale stated they intend to support individuals to have opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community. Individuals and the administrator meet at least monthly to plan community activities. The discussion is about what individuals would like to do and with whom, for example, do they want to go with or without their housemates/roommates. Individuals are encouraged to speak with the administrator or other staff to assist them with planning preferred activities based on their personal interests. A calendar of activities will be posted. All individuals are invited to participate in community activities. Individuals may choose to participate or not.
	All individuals are supported to access their community. If an individual cannot participate in community activities due to individually identified needs, staff will support the individual in participating in the community together with or separate from their housemates/roommates. Support will be described in the individual's person-centered plan. Any restriction to community participation is based on an assessed need, reviewed by the person-centered team at least annually, and documented in the person-centered plan.
	La Palma Royale developed a strategy to ensure that any restrictions were based on an assessed need, documented in the person-centered plan, and reviewed by the person-centered team at least annually. Supports and restrictions to accessing the community are based on individually assessed needs, documented in the person-centered plan, and reviewed at least annually. La Palma Royale intends to encourage individuals to be involved in their community as documented in their person-center plan that includes the individual's needs and preferences. Individuals can leave their home when they choose. They will have keys to the entrance/exit door(s) and the code to the keypad elevator unless there is a person-centered, need-based assessment documenting a need for an individualized restriction based on health and safety. Individuals can



go out alone or with family and friends unless there is an assessed need documented in their person-centered plan. Staff are available to go out with individuals, if needed. does not require staff to accompany an individual unless there is a person-centered assessment that addresses any health and safety concerns regarding going into the community unaccompanied.
To support individuals in having interactions with others living at La Palma Royale, individuals will be supported to attend activities of their choice throughout La Palma Royale. They will schedule activities with all individuals and support all individuals to attend as they would like to promote interaction.
