Individuals living at Megan's Place have limited opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community. Megan's Place has systemic and physical practices that impede an individuals' access to their community. Individuals are not permitted to leave their home without supervisor regardless of their skill/independence. Individuals do not have access to transportation. Individuals have limited opportunities to participate in community activities with their housemates/roommates.

Megan's Place encourages individuals to stay home after dinner and requires individuals to sign in and out when leaving their home.

Summary of Remediation Strategy

Megan's Place submitted a Remediation Work Plan (RWP) that described their efforts to increase opportunities for individuals to interact with the broader community. Staff provide the level of support needed so that individuals have transportation. The staff inform individuals of options, like public transportation, Access, or rideshare. Staff will assist individuals to arrange transportation or, if the individual wants or needs more support, the staff will arrange transportation. The administrator will gather and share information on transportation options including schedules, websites, phone numbers, and fees. Megan's Place will support individuals with the opportunity to participate in community activities with their housemates/roommates. Staff will provide the needed supports to ensure individuals execute their plans to participate in community activities with others. Staff will assist with arrangements and provide transportation, as needed.

All individuals are free to come and go into the community as they choose unless otherwise documented in their Individual Service Plan (ISP). Individuals go out alone, with family or friends, staff, or others in their home, unless otherwise documented in their ISP. Any restrictions are based on assessed needs, documented in the ISP, and reviewed at least



	annually. Individuals are not required to sign in an out when they leave unless otherwise documented in their ISP. Individuals are asked but not required to let staff know if they are going to be out longer than normal.
