Due to the design or model of service provision in the setting, individuals have limited, if any, opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community, including individuals not receiving Medicaid-funded HCBS

Summary of Evidence	Although not initially flagged for heightened scrutiny, a review on 01/17/2022 indicates that the provider has characteristics of an institutional setting that limits access to the community, Prong 3. The administrator said individuals are unable to leave their home for non-medical purposes, noting that individuals require levels of care that cannot be sustained in the community. There are no opportunities for individual or group activities in the community. The physician must give specific permission for individuals to leave their home for non-medical reasons.

Setting restricts individual choice to receive services or to engage in activities outside of the setting

Summary of Evidence	The administrator acknowledged that people can only leave the site for emergencies and medical appointments. They said activities and outings are not planned in the community due to the high levels of care and support that people require in the setting. They said information regarding access to transportation may not necessarily be shared with individuals because staff members are responsible for arranging transportation to and from medical appointments. The administrator said there is no need to enforce a curfew because individuals seldom leave the setting for non-medical purposes.

Setting is located separate and apart from the broader community without facilitating individual opportunity to access the broader community and participate in community services, consistent with an individual's person-centered plan

Summary of Evidence	The administrator implied that limited information is distributed to individuals regarding services in the broader community. They said people
	. The administrator said all activities take place onsite and stated that people are unable to leave the setting for non-medical purposes, noting that individuals in the setting require levels of care that cannot be sustained off site. The assessor did not observe these specific restrictions in care plans. The administrator said activities are not planned off site and noted that individuals are expected to remain in the setting over the course of their rehabilitation. They said activities in the home include watching television, reading, listening to music, praying, and spending time outside. The assessor did not observe an activity calendar in the setting. The administrator said the site offers both group and individual activities but reiterated that all activities take place in the setting. When asked if family members are able to take people off site for personal business, the administrator reiterated that people require levels of care that are not sustainable outside of the setting. They added that people would require specific permission from their physician to leave the setting for non-medical purposes.
