<p><b>Summary of Evidence</b></p>	<p>Individuals living at Strawberry Fields have limited opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community. Individuals do not have transportation for community activities except for medical appointments unless their family or friends can take them, or they can go independently. Strawberry Fields does not plan community activities as part of its plan for services. Individuals do not have the opportunity for community engagement with or without their housemates/roommates unless they are independent or have family or friends to take them.</p> <p>Strawberry Fields employs restrictive practices that impeded individual’s movement. There is a 10 pm curfew. Doors are alarmed. Individuals do not have keys to the doors that are locked at night.</p>
<p><b>Summary of Remediation Strategy</b></p>	<p>Strawberry Fields intends to change practices and systems to facilitate increased opportunity for community engagement. Strawberry Fields will, if an individual needs transportation for any community activity assist with transportation. Staff can provide transportation or arrange transportation with third-party transportation companies or with family members. If an individual wants or needs a companion or support, staff will accompany them.</p> <p>Strawberry Fields uses an activity calendar to share information about community activities with individuals. The staff speak with individuals to plan and schedule activities. Regularly staff and individuals discuss community activities they might be interested in based on their personal preferences. Individuals decide weekly what they would like to do. Staff will accompany and assist individuals in the community if needed. admission and annually after that. Individuals will be supported to participate in community activities together with or separate from their housemates/roommates. Individuals participate in a variety of activities including shopping or running personal errands. Frequently during breakfast staff and individuals plan activities for the day such as going to a movie, out to eat, or shopping.</p> <p>Strawberry Fields developed a system to ensure that individuals are supported to participate in community activities based on their preferences, abilities, and needs. Strawberry Fields says they do not have a curfew or dictate when individuals must be home. The policy says, “come and go as you please.”</p>



	<p>All individuals will be provided a key to the front door unless there is an assessed need documented in their person-centered plan. Any restrictions to having a key are based on an individually assessed need, documented in the ISP, and reviewed at least annually.</p> <p>Strawberry Fields will discontinue the use of alarms or chimes on the doors. If there is an assessed need that warrants the use of chimes, there will be individualized interventions. The use of chimes will be based on an assessed need, documented in the person-centered plan, and reviewed at least annually.</p>
