Summary of Evidence	Genesis Manor II does not support individuals to have opportunities for interaction in and with the broader community. Individuals rely on family members for community integration. Genesis Manor only supports individuals with transportation for medical appointments. Genesis Manor does not plan community activities for individuals or groups. Individuals do not have the opportunity to go out with or separate from their housemates/roommates. Individuals are not supported to participate in integrated activities such as adult day or senior programs. There are practices at Genesis Manor that impact an individual's ability to access the community. They are required to sign in/out when leaving and the use of door chimes and video monitoring.
Summary of Remediation Strategy	Genesis Manor has developed a plan that states they intend to support individuals to have opportunities for engagement in the broader community. They will share information regarding public transportation, ride share, and taxi services. Staff will be available to assist with contacting or arranging transportation.
	Using the Individual Service Plan (ISPs), the staff will document individuals' preferences, goals, and interests. Staff will have regular conversations with individuals about their likes and interests. Genesis Manor will use that information to create a monthly calendar that lists various community activities. Individuals will be supported to participate in outings of their choice and encouraged to provide input about what they would like to do and places they would like to go. The staff will support individuals by providing transportation or going with individuals based on their needs as documented in their ISP. Activities may be with other individuals in the home or separate from their housemates/roommates. Individuals are free to come and go on their own unless there is an assessed need documented in their ISP.



Genesis Manor will provide a copy of a community resources handout to each individual and display one in the home. The handout will include information about local adult day programs, senior center programs, employment opportunities, or other community resources/programs.

Genesis Manor developed a process for ensuring that modifications or restrictions are put in place only based on an individual assessed need, documented in the ISP, and reviewed at least annually. Individuals are free to come and go as they choose unless there is an assessed need documented in their ISP. All restrictions will be reviewed no less than annually. If individuals are unable to access the community without assistance, family, friends, or staff can accompany the individual.

Genesis Manor says that individuals are not required to sign in and out when they leave. Individuals do not have a curfew. Genesis Manor explained that they ask individuals to let the staff know if they expect to be out later than usual. It is a courtesy and not a requirement. Genesis Manor will continue to use chimes. However, they explained that the chimes are not used to track or restrict individuals. It is used to notify staff that someone has opened the door. Genesis Manor will update their admission agreement to explain the purpose of the chimes so that individuals are aware of their use.
