
Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) Transition Planning Stakeholder Meeting Notice

Background

On March 24, 2011, Assembly Bill (AB) 97 was enacted which authorized the elimination of the current Medi-Cal ADHC program, an optional Medi-Cal benefit under California's State Medicaid Plan. The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and the California Department of Aging are developing plans to help transition current ADHC recipients to other services.
