

SUBJECT: Denying Pending Applications from both the California Health Eligibility,

Enrollment and Retention System (CalHEERS) and the Statewide Automated

Welfare System (SAWS) Access Channels

As prescribed in Medi-Cal Eligibility Division Information Letter (MEDIL) I 14-23 and I 14-30, counties shall deny applications from all access channels that have failed to provide outstanding information, such as income verifications, after the ex parte review and the two 10-day requests, as required by All County Welfare Director's Letter 08-07. Until the negative actions functionality is ready in CalHEERS to allow counties to initiate negative actions in SAWS, the Department of Health Care Services is instructing counties to continue following the prescribed policies as outlined in MEDILs I 14-23 and I 14-30.

Specific instructions on interim procedures to deny pending applications will be issued by each SAWS. Counties are to contact their respective consortium for instructions on this process. As a reminder, although federally required quality control reviews are being conducted, counties shall continue to be held harmless for interim workarounds, as outlined in MEDIL I 14-14, in the absence of available system functionalities for certain eligibility functions.
