SUBJECT: 2006/2007 FAMILY-MEMBER MAXIMUM BASE ALLOCATION AMOUNT

This is to provide counties with the updated family-member maximum base allocation amount (per Section 1924(d) of the Social Security Act). The family-member maximum base allocation amount is used to determine how much the long-term care (LTC) beneficiary may allocate to family members. Effective July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007, this family-member base allocation amount (for use in Section IX, A.2 and B.2 of the Allocation/Special Deduction Worksheet B—Form MAW (1/90)) for a family member living with the community spouse of a beneficiary with LTC status is \$1,650. (The 2005/2006 family-member maximum base allocation amount was \$1,604.)
