SUBJECT: ERRATA TO ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS' LETTER 11-24:

MANDATORY MEDI-CAL MANAGED CARE FOR SENIORS AND

PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

The purpose of this errata is to include an important clarification, which was inadvertently omitted from the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), All County Welfare Directors' Letter No. 11-24. The clarification is as follows:

To ensure continuity of care, Seniors and Persons with Disabilities (SPDs) subject to mandatory enrollment in managed care will be given the opportunity to work with their health plan and continue to see their current provider out of network for up to 12 months from the date of enrollment in the health plan.
