

SUBJECT: 2011/2012 FAMILY MEMBER BASE ALLOCATION AMOUNT

(Reference: All County Welfare Directors Letter Number 10-15).

The purpose of this letter is to provide counties with the updated family member base allocation amount (per Section 1924(d) of the Social Security Act). The family member base allocation amount is used to determine how much the long-term care (LTC) beneficiary may allocate to family members.

Effective July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012, the family member base allocation amount (for use in Section IX, A.2 and B.2 of the Allocation/Special Deduction Worksheet B, Form MC 176W (05/08)) for a family member living with the community spouse of a beneficiary with LTC status is \$1839. The 2009-2011 family member base allocation amount was \$1822.
